## ☐ What Does "Minimum Residence Requirement" means?

- O Minimum Residence Requirement
  - : Refers to the minimum term required to complete a course of study
    - Masters & Doctoral Program : 4 semesters
    - Integrated Program: 8 semesters
- O Students who have acquired a number of credits greater than that required to be awarded a degree, the time required for graduation from the school may be reduced by 1 semester for master's and doctorate courses and by up to 1 ~ 2 semester for integrated courses.
  - ⇒ Early Course Completion/Graduation



<sup>\*</sup>According to the Academic Regulation, the GPA for all semesters must be  $A^{\circ}(4.0/4.5)$  or higher for students entering the Fall semester of 2021

## ☐ Application Requirements and Procedure to Shorten Minimum Residence Requirement

- Application and approval period: 2021.12.20.(Mon) ~ 2022. 1. 7.(Fri)
  - Application of UST portal and approval from advisor is required within the deadline.



#### □ Note

- Students who wish to complete(or graduate) early for this semester are required to apply.
- Even if there is an application to shorten their Minimum Residence Requirement, the application may be rejected depending on application requirements.
  - If the requirements have not been satisfied, the students must enroll and take classes just like their peers for the remaining semesters.
- Some campuses has own criteria of degree acquirement students should check that all the required courses is already completed if there are any in the curriculum to meet the degree acquirement.

<sup>\*</sup> in order to complete the total required number of minimum credits, students must complete additional coursework with at least the minimum number of credits for each program

E.g.: Master's and Ph.D. students are required to receive 2 common core course credits, 12 major course credits, 12 field research credits, and 2 seminar course credits for a total of 28 credits. Thus, they must earn an additional 4 credits in any courses they choose to meet the required 32 total credits.
